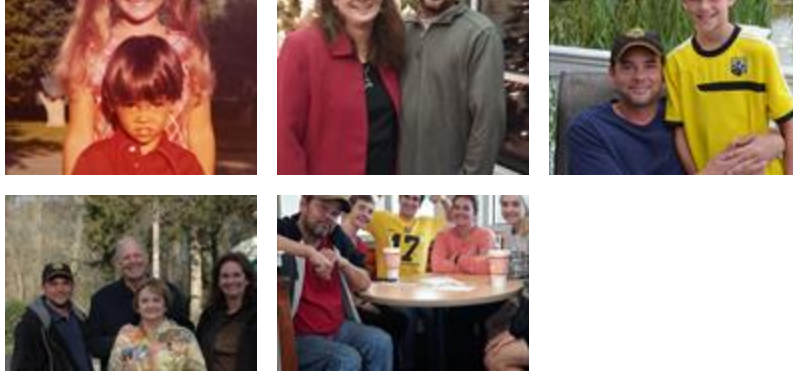
Though his illness took him too soon, Andre's big heart and love for his sons will be remembered forever. He's now watching over them as their guardian angel, with a new beginning in a better place.
