



George Patterson Crandall, III

December 8, 1950 - November 15, 2023

George Patterson Crandall III, a loving husband of 48 years, a father of three and Papa to eleven grand-blessings, 72, died November 15, 2023 in Jacksonville, FL. He was born December 8, 1950 in Ridgefield, New Jersey, but was raised at the Choate School in Wallingford, CT by his parents, George Patterson Crandall, Jr. (a teacher and coach there) and his mother Joan DeMott Crandall. After graduating from Choate, he went to Stanford University and was awarded his BA in Psychology, German, and Naval Science in 1973. He later obtained a Master's degree from Jacksonville University in 1981 in English and Education. He was a Naval Flight Officer in the US Navy and retired after 20 years in 1993, after teaching English for three years at the US Naval Academy. He then taught English and Psychology at Episcopal School of Jacksonville from 1993 to 2020, where he also coached the Boys Varsity Soccer team for 10 years and the Track team for 20 years. He is survived by his loving wife, Jackie Ann Ferguson Crandall and his three children's families:
